50 permitted at religious services at places of worship subject to the four-square-metre rule.. "Places of worship will be asked to find alternatives to practices that might spread the virus like group singing, sharing books and even passing around the collection plate to reduce infection risks"..."Communal singing and chanting should not occur because of the high risk of transmission of the virus. Instead, measures such as one singer standing at least 3 metres away from others would be safer."

 A maximum of 10 people can attend a religious gathering, or attend a place of worship for private worship. Services can be streamed or recorded to enable people to engage in worship. People attending a place of public worship will be required to provide their name and contact details when they enter so that they can be used for contact tracing.
